## State of the art in project partner countries according Gender Equality Index sub-domain of political power


The Gender Equality index is a tool developed by the EIGE with the objective to measure gender gaps and the progress of gender quality in the EU. It gives more visibility to areas that need improvement and ultimately supports policymakers to design more effective gender equality measures.

The **sub-domain** of political power **examines the representation of women and men in national parliaments, government and regional/local assemblies.** 

The overall political power in <u>EU is 60.2</u>. The scores of the political power indicator in project's partner countries are as follows: Cyprus 34.6; Greece 36.2; Italy 58.8; Lithuania 54.7; Portugal 64.5; Spain 87.4 and Sweden 95.5. The index uses a scale from 1 to 100, where a score of 100 would mean that a country had reached full equality between women and men.


# Share of women members in national parliaments in project partner countries (%)

Men






### Share of women ministers in governments in project partner countries (%) Women Men

EU-wide data show that women are still under-represented in political decision-making at **local**, **national and EU levels**. The Gender Equality Index shows that although 'power' is the area where most progress has been made in the **past 10 years**, **it is** also **the area where the gender gap remains widest**.
